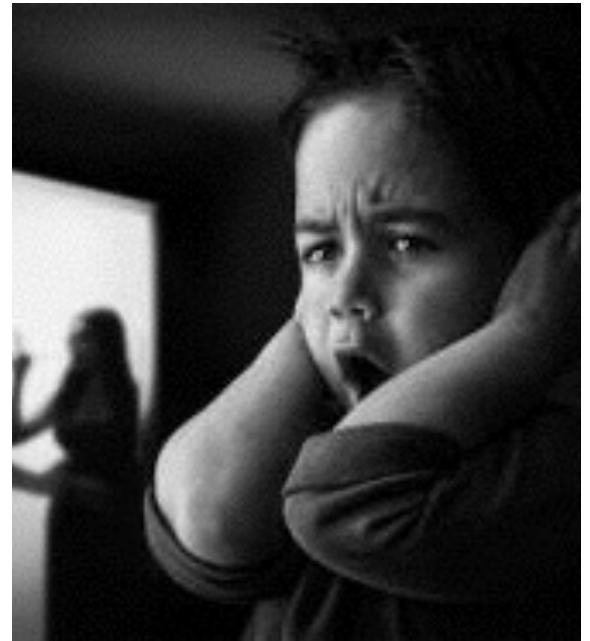


# Domestic Violence Response Workshop: "The Impact of Domestic Violence on Children"
