

What is VINE?

Victim Information and Notification Everyday is a free, automated system that allows you 24-hour access to register for notification of an inmate's custody status and any changes that may occur. You will be notified if an inmate is released, transferred, or escapes from jail.

How can VINE help me?

VINE allows you 24-hour, 7 days a week, access to inmates' custody status. Once you have registered, the automated system will notify you of any changes in the inmate's status.

VINE can offer you peace of mind to know the location of the offender while the inmate is in custody.

When there is a custody status change of an inmate, you will be notified either by phone, email, or both—whichever you have previously registered for.

How do I register?

There are two ways to register for VINE:

Call **1-800-467-4963** from a touchtone phone and follow the instructions. Please have the name of the inmate, the phone number in which you want to receive calls, and a 4-digit PIN number ready to give (this PIN number should be something easy for you to remember).

You can also register online at **www.vinelink.com**. From there, you will select the state of Virginia and then search the inmate's name. You will then be able to select how you would like to be notified (phone, email, or both).

The system is not required to reach you in order to release the inmate from custody. It is only required to contact you on the number and/or email you provided. If you do not answer the phone, VINE will leave a voicemail message if available. If there is no answering service, VINE will keep calling back until you enter your PIN or until 24 hours has passed.
